FAUNISTIC RECORDS FROM THE CZECH REPUBLIC

Diptera: Scatopsidae

Anapausis floricola Chandler, 1999

Trinec-Sosna, 980m, 49°46'N, 18°44'E, edge of wood, yellow pan trap, 24-27.VII.1996, 2 males, leg. Barták, coll. Barták and coll. Muséum Neuchâtel, det. Haenni. The species belongs to the species-group of *A. soluta* Loew, 1846 from which it was only recently differentiated (CHANDLER 1999). *A. floricola* is known from certainty only from Great Britain and few localities in Germany, Switzerland and the Czech republic (Bohemia) (HAENNI 2004). However it may prove to be more widely distributed since published records of *A. soluta* probably partly refer to *A. floricola*. First record for Moravia.

Anapausis haemorrhoidalis Duda, 1928

Horská Kvilda – Borová Lada, car-net, 28.VI.1992, 1 male, leg. et coll. Barták, det. Haenni. This species has a Central European distribution, having been recorded from France, the Netherlands, Germany, Austria, Czech republic (Moravia), Slovakia and Poland (HAENNI 2004). First record for Bohemia.

Anapausis helvetica Haenni, 1984

Lnáře – 5km N, 400m, 49°29'N, 13°47'E, on flowering *Daucaceae*, 18.VIII.1989, 1 male, leg. et coll. Barták, det. Haenni. This little known species is recorded from temperate Europe, i.e France, Italy, Switzerland, Germany, Czech

republic (Moravia) and Slovakia (HAENNI 2004). First record for Bohemia.

Colobostema infumatum (Haliday, 1833)

Šumava-Jezerní slat', 980m, 49°02'N, 13°34'E, peat-bog, pan trap, 2-18.VI.1995, 4 males, leg. Barták, coll. Barták and coll. Muséum Neuchâtel, det. Haenni. This species is probably widely distributed in Europe but only scattered records are known from Northern Ireland, Great Britain, Norway, Finland, Russia (North) and Switzerland (HAENNI 2004). It has been quite frequently caught in peat-bogs. First record for the Czech republic (Bohemia).

Swammerdamella adercotris Cook, 1972

Beskydy, Muřínkový vrch, 950m, 49°31'N, 18°39'E, peat-bog, 13.VI.1987, 1 male, leg. et coll. Barták, det. Haenni. A poorly known species recorded from Scandinavia (Norway, Sweden, Finland) and temperate Europe (France, Switzerland, Germany, Czech republic (Bohemia) and Slovakia) (HAENNI 2004). It is quite often caught in peat-bogs. First record for Moravia.
